Closure● No Open House - just testing on iReady and DIBELS and possibly statewide testing in Spring.● 3 Year plan on hold for now.● We don't follow a plan-COVID dictates our plan, depending on numbers● 192 students enrolled this year.● DOH metrics used to determine how school will look during the 2nd quarter.● Only allowed to bring 25% of total students that are non-acellus - later in 2nd quarter move towards having 50% of students, but the goal is to have 100% of students come back to school by <u>3rd quarter</u> if conditions improve.● Only 30 students total will be brought back on campus.● Safety measures have to be in place.● Slow transition to return back to school.● November will need to look at next year's budget.
