The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) requires our school to notify the faculty, staff and parents of the presence and status of asbestos containing materials on our school buildings. The law further requires a management plan based upon the findings of the initial inspection.

We have conducted the required six months surveillance in June 2020, and will complete the next surveillance in December 2020. The results of the recently completed surveillance indicate there have been no changes in the condition of the asbestos containing materials in our school buildings.
